Application deadline February 1st

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a US citizen or permanent, legal resident of the State of Rhode Island or towns in southeastern Massachusetts with RIFGC-affiliates
- Must be attending, as a full-time student, any fully-accredited college/university listed US Department of Education website
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 on a 4.0 scale
- Must be planning a career related to the environment
- Majors in the following fields of study will be considered: Agricultural Education, Agronomy,
 Botany, Biology, City Planning (Urban and Rural), Environmental Concerns (Management:
 Environmental, Horticulture Resource/Environmental Behavior), Environmental Conservation
 (including Engineering), Forestry, Habitat or Forest Systems Ecology), Horticulture, Floriculture,
 Landscape Design, Plant Pathology/Science, Wildlife Science, Land Management, and other related
 subjects.

Recommendations	5%
Conformance with application procedures	2%

- Personal statement/essay (Discuss background, financial need, future career goals not to exceed 1 page)
- List of extracurricular activities, honors, recognitions received within the last 3 years (1 page, front side only)
- Two letters of recommendation 1 page, front side only
- Cover letter from applicant

All documents must be mailed together in one large envelope. No staples, page protectors or binders. Mail to the Scholarship Chair, Life Member Group, RIFGC (see *rigardenclubs.org for contact information.*) One RIFGC applicant will be selected from each year's Life Member Group application pool to compete for a National Garden Club Scholarship. It is for this reason that applicants are asked to submit both the RIFGC application and the NGC application at the same time. **Applications must be received by February 1**st
